HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each situation and its choices aloud. Children circle an action and explain how it helps keep people safe. Children and adults both follow safety rules.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • HOME AND SCHOOL

SAY “Listen to each situation. Circle the choice that follows a safety rule.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	People are moving through a busy school hallway. Which action helps prevent bumps and falls? Choices: WALK, RUN, PUSH.	WALK
b	The smoke alarm sounds at home. Your grown-up leads you along your escape route. What should you do with the grown-up? Choices: PLAY, LEAVE, HIDE.	LEAVE

PART 2 • AROUND TOWN

SAY “Now choose a safe action in the community. After you circle, tell what could happen if someone ignored the rule.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	You and your grown-up are at a crosswalk. The signal says not to cross yet. What should you both do? Choices: WAIT, RUN, JUMP.	WAIT
b	You want to pet a dog on a leash. Before going near the dog, what should you do with its owner? Choices: TOUCH, ASK, CHASE.	ASK

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Part 1: WALK, LEAVE. Part 2: WAIT, ASK. Accept sound oral explanations, such as preventing falls or bites. Follow school emergency procedures.
