HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each sequence slowly, once or twice as needed, while students use the printed shapes to show the last action. In Part 2, listen for each partner to repeat the sequence clearly and in order before the other partner circles a shape. Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • LISTEN FIRST

SAY “I will say three actions for each row. Can you do the actions in order, then circle the shape you touched last?”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Will you touch the left shape first, tap your desk once next, and touch the right shape last? Which shape did you touch last? Circle it.	triangle
b	Will you touch the middle shape first, clap once next, and touch the left shape last? Which shape did you touch last? Circle it.	star
c	Will you touch the right shape first, touch your shoulder next, and touch the middle shape last? Which shape did you touch last? Circle it.	rectangle

PART 2 • TELL A PARTNER

SAY “Take turns being the speaker and the listener. The speaker repeats my directions in order, and the listener does the actions and circles the last shape.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Partner 1, can you tell Partner 2 these directions: touch the right shape first, clap once next, and touch the middle shape last? Partner 2, which shape did you touch last? Circle it.	star
b	Partner 2, can you tell Partner 1 these directions: touch the left shape first, tap your knees once next, and touch the right shape last? Partner 1, which shape did you touch last? Circle it.	circle

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Part 1 answers are triangle, star, and rectangle. Part 2 answers are star and circle. Accept oral restatements when the speaker includes all three actions in the correct order, using equivalent words such as tap or pat.
