HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each sentence aloud, pausing at the missing word. Then read the choices aloud and have students circle the word that makes the whole sentence sound right. Students listen for whether the sentence is about one or more than one.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • PICK A VERB

SAY "Listen to each sentence and the three word choices. Which word makes the sentence sound right? Circle it."

a	Listen: "The dog blank fast." The choices are "run," "runs," and "running." Which word makes a complete sentence? Circle it.	runs
b	Listen: "Two ducks blank." The choices are "fly," "flies," and "flying." Which word makes a complete sentence? Circle it.	fly
c	Listen: "My friends blank." The choices are "jump," "jumps," and "jumping." Which word makes a complete sentence? Circle it.	jump
