HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each sentence and its choices aloud, then have students circle the word that tells where. Explain that a preposition tells where something is, such as beside in the sentence, “The bird sat beside the nest.”

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY “Listen to each sentence. I will read the three words in the row. Which word tells where?”

a	In the sentence, “The cat is under the table,” which word tells where? The choices are under, table, and cat. Circle the word that tells where.	under
b	In the sentence, “I sit on the chair,” which word tells where? The choices are chair, on, and sit. Circle the word that tells where.	on
c	In the sentence, “The toy is in the box,” which word tells where? The choices are box, toy, and in. Circle the word that tells where.	in
