HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each sentence and row prompt aloud, giving students time to look closely and circle one choice. In Part 1, students find the word that begins a sentence. In Part 2, students find the capital word used when a speaker talks about themselves.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • SENTENCE STARTS

SAY “I will say a sentence and ask you about the words in each row. Listen, look carefully, and circle one word for each row.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Listen: Cats nap. Which printed word should have a capital letter because it starts the sentence? Circle it.	Cats
b	Listen: We play. Which printed word should have a capital letter because it starts the sentence? Circle it.	We
c	Listen: Birds fly. Which printed word should have a capital letter because it starts the sentence? Circle it.	Birds

PART 2 • SPECIAL I

SAY “Now listen to each sentence and look at the three printed choices. Which choice shows the word a speaker uses to talk about themselves? Circle it.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Listen: I can run. Which printed choice shows the word the speaker uses to talk about themselves? Circle it.	I
b	Listen: I see a bug. Which printed choice shows the word the speaker uses to talk about themselves? Circle it.	I
c	Listen: I like cake. Which printed choice shows the word the speaker uses to talk about themselves? Circle it.	I
