- ② Omar asked, “How often should we water the plant?” Ms. Chen answered, “Check the soil each morning. If the top feels dry, add a little water.” Omar nodded and said, “So I should check before I water it.”
- ③ Later, Priya said, “The leaves look droopy.” Omar listened and asked, “Do droopy leaves always mean the plant needs water?” Ms. Chen replied, “Not always. The soil tells us more.” Priya answered, “We can check the soil together.”
