Beavers Change Water

- ① Beavers are busy animals that live near ponds, streams, and lakes. They use their strong teeth to cut small trees and branches. Then they carry the wood to the water, where they build homes called lodges.
- ② A beaver can also build a dam across moving water. The dam slows the water and helps make a pond. The pond gives the beaver a safer place to swim, find food, and hide from some enemies.
- ③ Beavers do not build only for themselves. Their ponds can become homes for frogs, fish, ducks, and insects. When beavers change a stream into a pond, they can change the place where many other animals live.
