Beaver Homes

- ① Beavers build homes called lodges in ponds and slow streams. A lodge is made of sticks and mud. Its underwater door helps a beaver enter safely. Beavers are mostly active at night.

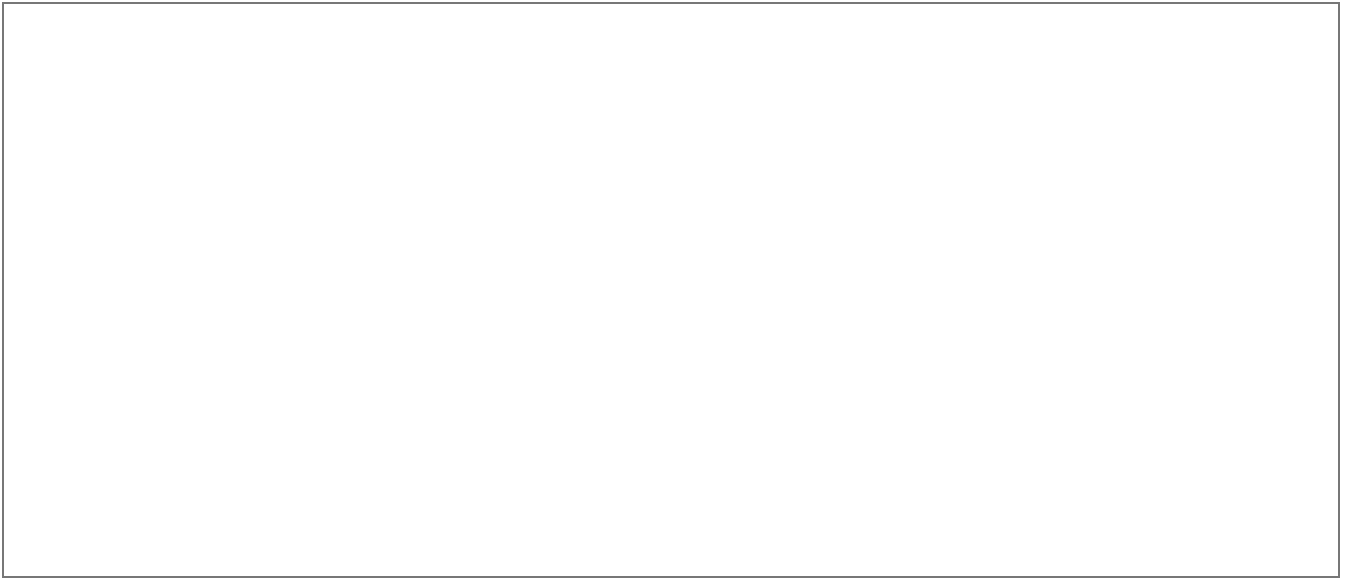
