2	Next month, we will visit the aquarium.	MATCHES	"Next month" shows the future, and "will visit" is future tense.
3	Right now, the baby slept.	MIXED UP	"Right now" shows the present, but "slept" is past tense.
4	Every morning, I pack my lunch.	MATCHES	"Every morning" shows a present habit, and "pack" is present tense.
5	Last Friday, the band will perform.	MIXED UP	"Last Friday" shows the past, but "will perform" is future tense.
6	Tomorrow, the storm rumbled.	MIXED UP	"Tomorrow" shows the future, but "rumbled" is past tense.
7	Soon, the seedling grew tall.	MIXED UP	"Soon" shows the future, but "grew" is past tense.
8	Last year, our class planted tomatoes.	MATCHES	"Last year" shows the past, and "planted" is past tense.
