She pointed to the Yellowstone River and said that hot water shapes the park's famous geysers. Maya wrote the names in her notebook so she could remember where she had traveled that day.
- ② Later, Ranger Ortiz described a winter event in the park. Each year, families visit during the days around New Year's Day, a federal holiday. Maya learned that the park is mostly in Wyoming, but small parts reach Montana and Idaho. She wondered how snow changes the trails near the mountains each winter when cold weather arrives.
- ③ Before leaving, Maya thanked Ranger Ortiz for the tour. Her family planned to return on Memorial Day and camp near the river. Uncle Devon wanted to drive from their home in Boise, Idaho, to the park. Maya checked the map again and drew a star beside the Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone, where waterfalls roar.
