- ② Later, Nia saw Mr. Cruz, the custodian, carrying a rake and a trash bag. She remembered that the bench helped many people, not only her. Nia asked two friends to help. Together, they piled the leaves, filled the bag, and swept the bench dry. Mr. Cruz thanked them and brought a small bucket for the last bits.
- ③ At recess the next day, a kindergartner sat on the clean bench while waiting for his sister. Nia and her friends used the bench to share a comic book. Nia noticed that cleaning had taken only a few minutes when people worked together. When she saw a wrapper by the slide, she picked it up before running to play.
