A Class Visit

- ② At the touch pool, the guide gave each student a wet hand towel. Maya held one over her fingers because the room felt cool. Her friend Luis found a starfish picture on a sign and read its facts aloud. Then the class ate lunch outside, where Maya chose an apple and drank water from her bottle.
- ③ Later, the group met a keeper near the penguin pool. He told them that penguins came from several parts of the Southern Hemisphere. Maya wrote that some penguins built nests with stones, while others kept eggs on their feet. Before leaving, she spoke to the keeper and said the visit had made her curious about ocean animals.
