PART 1 • SORT

#	ITEM	CATEGORY	WHY
1	The fox's den is hidden.	CORRECT	A singular noun, fox, owns the den, so the apostrophe comes before s.
2	The cousins' picnic was fun.	CORRECT	A plural noun ending in s, cousins, owns the picnic, so the apostrophe comes after s.
3	The horses stable needs cleaning.	FIX	The plural owner horses needs an apostrophe after s: horses' stable.
4	Dad's camera is on the shelf.	CORRECT	A singular noun, Dad, owns the camera, so the apostrophe comes before s.
5	The geese nest is empty.	FIX	The plural owner geese does not end in s, so it needs apostrophe s: geese's nest.
6	The girl's' bicycle has a bell.	FIX	Girl is singular, so it needs only one apostrophe before s: girl's bicycle.
7	The baker's bread smells warm.	CORRECT	A singular noun, baker, owns the bread, so the apostrophe comes before s.
8	The campers' lanterns lit the path.	CORRECT	A plural noun ending in s, campers, owns the lanterns, so the apostrophe comes after s.

PART 3 • MAKE YOUR OWN (SAMPLE ANSWERS)

- **CORRECT:** The artist's paintbrush is clean.
- **FIX:** The musicians instruments are packed.
