Morning at Cedar Marsh

- ① On a spring morning, a team of wildlife volunteers met beside the Cedar Marsh trail. They carried binoculars, notebooks, and gloves. Their leader explained that a flock of Canada geese had been seen near a blocked drainage pipe. The group planned to check the area along the wet trail without disturbing birds or nearby nests.
- ② At the pond, the team found fresh beaver tracks and a small dam made of branches and mud. A colony of beavers lived farther downstream, so the volunteers stayed on the path. Near the pipe, the flock of geese moved calmly into the reeds. Each bird watched the people, then followed the others toward open water.
- ③ Back at the visitor center, a committee of volunteers wrote a report about the blocked pipe. The committee asked the park manager to contact a repair crew. Meanwhile, the team cleaned its tools and shared observations. By afternoon, the geese had returned to the pond, and the marsh was quiet again in the late afternoon.
