A Garden Map Draft

- ① On Monday, our class began a project to map the school garden. First, we used clipboards to record the location of each plant. Maya wrote that the mint grew beside the fence, while Jordan measured the space between the tomato rows. We moved carefull so small seedlings, hidden under broad leaves, would not be stepped on.
- ② Next, the group made a simple key for the map. A blue square showed a water barrel, and a green triangle showed a compost bin. We chose symbols that were easy to recognize from far away. During recess, Priya said she could definately finish the title, but she asked a freind to check her spelling before printing it.
- ③ On Friday, we compared our map with the real garden. The class discovered that one path was narrower than we had expected. We also added a note about the buterfly bushes, since they attract insects. Our final map will help new students find tools, plants, and seeting areas without getting lost in the garden each day.
