A Museum Visit

- ① On Thursday, Maya Chen visited the National Air and Space Museum in Washington, D.C., with her science club. At the entrance, a guide explained that the museum is part of the Smithsonian Institution. Maya checked a map from NASA and chose the gallery about the Apollo 11 mission. She paused beside a model of the Apollo Lunar Module, where astronauts Neil Armstrong and Buzz Aldrin prepared to land on the Moon in 1969. Her teacher, Ms. Rivera, asked everyone to record one surprising detail in a notebook.
- ② Later, the club met near the Wright brothers' 1903 Flyer. Maya's friend Jordan Lee remembered visiting the National Museum of American History on a family trip. A guide described how engineers at the Federal Aviation Administration, or FAA, set safety rules for air travel. Jordan noticed that FAA uses the first letters of its full name. Their club also thanked the PTA at Lincoln Middle School for paying for the bus. The group left a thank-you card at the office before departing.
- ③ Before leaving, Maya wrote a short report for Dr. Elena Park, the club adviser. She cited an article from the U.S. Department of Transportation and added a link to the Civil Air Patrol website. In her last paragraph, Maya compared NASA's careful planning with the work of the FAA. She also mentioned that her uncle served in the U.S. Navy. By checking each name and abbreviation, Maya made her report clear and professional for her classmates.
