Garden Build Notice

- ① Families of Riverbend Middle School, the student garden team invites you to a Saturday Garden Build on April 18, from 9:00 to 11:30 a.m. We will add soil to the raised beds, plant pollinator flowers, and repair the compost bin behind the library. Students may come with an adult. Wear closed-toe shoes and bring work gloves if you have them. The school will provide tools, water, and a place to wash hands before heading home afterward.
- ② This notice appears in the family newsletter and on the school website because adults need the schedule and safety details before deciding whether to attend. The short heading and first sentence tell busy readers what the event is and who is invited. Specific directions, including the location behind the library, help families plan. A contact email, garden@riverbendms.org, lets readers ask about accessibility needs or volunteer jobs. The team checked spelling, dates, and times before the notice was posted.
- ③ To reach families who cannot attend, the garden team will publish a short update after the build. It will list what was completed, show one or two labeled photos, and explain the next volunteer date. The update will not include students' last names or photos of students without permission. These choices respect privacy while sharing useful news with the school community. Clear, correct information makes the notice easier for its audience to use and trust.
