Water Within Reach

- ① At Pine Ridge Middle School, students should have more water-bottle refill stations. The cafeteria has one fountain, but a long line forms after lunch, and many students choose packaged drinks instead. Refill stations can quickly fill reusable bottles, so students can get water between classes. Installing more stations would also make it easier for students who carry bottles for sports practice. The school should place a station near the gym and another near the sixth-grade hall.
- ② Some adults might claim that new refill stations cost too much. However, the school already spends money collecting piles of single-use bottles from lunch areas. A station that encourages reusable bottles could reduce that waste over time. Students could also bring bottles from home instead of buying a drink when the fountain line is long. The main issue is not whether students need water. It is whether the school should make drinking water easier to reach. More stations are a practical solution.
- ③ For these reasons, school leaders should ask students where lines are longest before choosing station locations. A short survey could show which hallways need easier access to water. The principal can then use that information to plan the project and explain the choice to families. More refill stations will not solve every problem at school, but they can improve a daily need. Pine Ridge Middle School should add them because students deserve a simple way to get water during the day.
