HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Tell students that some words tell where something is. Model the idea orally with a different location word, such as near, then read each row and let students mark their own answers.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY “Listen to each sentence. I will read the words in the boxes too. Can you circle the word that tells where?”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	The puppy naps in the bed. The words are on, in, under. Which word tells where?	in
b	The kite flies over the hill. The words are in, under, over. Which word tells where?	over
c	The cat sits beside the box. The words are beside, between, over. Which word tells where?	beside

PART 2 • TRACE WORDS

SAY “Look at the gray word in each box. Can you trace each gray word?”
