HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each prompt and its three choices aloud. Students listen for whether the pronoun is doing an action, receiving an action, or showing who owns something, then circle the word that fits.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • I, ME, MY

SAY "Can you listen to each little sentence and circle the word that fits?"
