HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read every choice aloud and give students time to mark their answers. In this activity, students help build an informational page by choosing a fitting title, identifying facts, and dictating true information for you to record.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CHOOSE IT

SAY “We are making a page that teaches true information. Listen as I read the choices in each row, then circle the choice that fits the question.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Our page tells about the outlined shapes below. I will read the titles: Letters, Shapes, Numbers. Which title fits our page?	Shapes
b	I will read the words: song, game, facts. Which word names true information?	facts

PART 2 • ADD FACTS

SAY “Look at each outlined shape. What true fact can you tell me about it? Say your fact, and I will write your words in my notes. Then trace the gray words in each box to add facts to your page.”

- Box 1 (beside triangle): **3 sides**
- Box 2 (beside square): **4 sides**
- Box 3 (beside pentagon): **5 sides**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Circle Shapes in the first row and facts in the second row. Accept accurate tracing of each fact and an orally dictated true fact about each labeled shape, such as, "A square has four sides."
