HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Tell students that the dots in Part 2 show results from a class question you already asked. Read every choice aloud in Part 1, then listen as students share the numbers they record in Part 2. The skill is shown when students choose a fitting way to share a result and communicate a result aloud or in writing.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CHOOSE A WAY

SAY “Listen to each sharing plan. I will read the three choices in every row: Say, Write, Both. Which choice fits the plan?”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	You will tell your partner the result with your voice. Which choice fits?	Say
b	Someone will read your result on a page later. Which choice fits?	Write
c	You will show a written number and tell the result aloud. Which choice fits?	Both

PART 2 • SHARE NUMBERS

SAY “Each group of dots shows a result from our class question. How many dots do you see in each box? Write the number, then tell a partner the result you wrote.”

- Box 1 (beside 3 dots): **3**
- Box 2 (beside 5 dots): **5**
- Box 3 (beside 7 dots): **7**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Part 1 answers are Say, Write, Both. In Part 2, accept 3, 5, and 7, in any readable numeral form, and listen for the student to say the recorded result to a partner.
