HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Use a real classroom book that has a clear front cover, back cover, and title page. Before Part 2, place the three paper shape markers on the book parts listed in the answer key.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY “Look at our book. For each row, listen as I point to one part of the book, then circle the words that name that part.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	I am pointing to the outside at the beginning of the book. The choices are Back Cover, Front Cover, and Title Page. Which words name this part?	Front Cover
b	I am pointing to the outside at the end of the book. The choices are Title Page, Front Cover, and Back Cover. Which words name this part?	Back Cover
c	I opened the book to the page near the beginning that tells the book's name. The choices are Title Page, Back Cover, and Front Cover. Which words name this page?	Title Page

PART 2 • DRAW LINES

SAY “Look at the book with the paper shape markers. Find each shape on the book, then draw a line from that shape to the words that name the marked book part.”

- **circle** matches **Front Cover**
- **square** matches **Back Cover**
- **triangle** matches **Title Page**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Part 1 answers are Front Cover, Back Cover, and Title Page. For Part 2, place a circle marker on the front cover, a square marker on the back cover, and a triangle marker on the title page. Accept lines that clearly connect each shape to its matching label.
