HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each clue set slowly, and repeat it once as needed. Students listen for more than one detail, put the details together, and use the marks on the page to show the place they infer.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CLUE CIRCLES

SAY “Listen to each set of clues. Put the clues together in your mind, then circle the place you think the clues tell about.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Tia sees a barn. She hears chickens and sees a tractor. Is Tia at a beach, a library, or a farm? Circle the place you infer from the clues.	farm
b	Noah feels sand under his feet. He hears waves and finds a shell. Is Noah at a farm, a beach, or a library? Circle the place you infer from the clues.	beach
c	Mina chooses two books to borrow. She promises to bring them back later. Is Mina at a beach, a library, or a farm? Circle the place you infer from the clues.	library

PART 2 • STORY LINES

SAY “Listen to this story. Kai is quiet and picks a book to borrow. Uma runs to a swing and goes down a slide. Rio smells warm bread and sees rolls come from an oven. Where is each child? Draw a line from each name to the place you infer from the clues.”

- **Kai** matches **library**
- **Uma** matches **park**
- **Rio** matches **bakery**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Clue Circles answers are farm, beach, library. Story Lines matches Kai to library, Uma to park, and Rio to bakery; accept lines that clearly connect each correct pair.
