HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read the page titles and prompts aloud, pausing so students can look closely at each large graphic. Students show that a title tells what a page is about by matching a printed title to a simple graphic and choosing graphics that fit spoken titles.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • MATCH PAGES

SAY “Look at the titles on the left. I will read each title. Which graphic belongs with each title? Draw a line to match them.”

- **Round** matches **circle**
- **Three** matches **3 dots**
- **Star** matches **star**

PART 2 • FIND CLUES

SAY “Listen to each page title and look at the graphics. Which graphic fits the title? Circle it.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	The title says “Circle.” Which graphic fits this title?	circle
b	The title says “Four.” Which group of dots fits this title?	4 dots
c	The title says “Triangle.” Which graphic fits this title?	triangle

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Match Round to the circle, Three to 3 dots, and Star to the star. Circle the circle in row 1, 4 dots in row 2, and the triangle in row 3.
