HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

This sheet lets students match standard numbers to expanded forms and identify small quantities shown with dot groups. Read each prompt aloud, then have students circle or draw lines to show hundreds, tens, and ones in numbers through 120.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • DOT GROUPS

SAY “Look at each row of dot groups. Listen for the number, then circle the dot group that shows how many.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Which dot group has 7 dots? Circle it.	7 dots
b	Which dot group has 12 dots? Circle it.	12 dots

PART 2 • MATCH PARTS

SAY “Look at the numbers on the left and the number parts on the right. Which number parts match each number? Draw a line from each number to its matching number parts.”

- **24** matches **20+4**
- **58** matches **50+8**
- **112** matches **100+10+2**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Dot Groups: circle 7 dots in row 1 and 12 dots in row 2. Match 24 to 20+4, 58 to 50+8, and 112 to 100+10+2.
