HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Before Part 1, demonstrate measuring a blank paper strip with same-size units placed end to end, then compare the count with a longer unit. Read each clue aloud, repeat it once if needed, and have students circle one large choice in each row.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • MEASURE IT

SAY “Listen to each measurement clue. After I read the choices, circle the answer that matches the clue.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	When same-size units measure a length, should they be touching, have gaps, or overlap? Circle the word that tells how the units should be placed.	Touching
b	A ribbon is 3 long blocks long. Short blocks are half as long as the long blocks. Would the ribbon take 3, 9, or 6 short blocks? Circle the number.	6
c	A string measures 5 centimeters and a little more, but it is less than halfway to 6 centimeters. Is its nearest whole length 4 centimeters, 5 centimeters, or 6 centimeters? Circle the length.	5cm

PART 2 • CLOCK CLUES

SAY “Listen to each clock clue. Circle the digital time that matches the clock hands I describe.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	The minute hand points to 12. The hour hand points to 4. Is the time 4:30, 5:00, or 4:00? Circle the digital time.	4:00
b	The minute hand points to 6. The hour hand is halfway between 8 and 9. Is the time 8:30, 8:00, or 9:30? Circle the digital time.	8:30
c	The minute hand points to 6. The hour hand is halfway between 1 and 2. Is the time 2:00, 1:30, or 2:30? Circle the digital time.	1:30

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Part 1 answers are Touching, 6, and 5cm. Part 2 answers are 4:00, 8:30, and 1:30.
