Use equal groups to find a total.

EQUAL GROUPS

Equal groups have the same number in each group. To find the total after groups are joined, add the number in each group again and again. You can also describe the groups by saying how many groups there are and how many are in each group.

WORKED EXAMPLE

There are 5 jars. Each jar has 7 buttons. How many buttons are there?

1. There are 5 equal groups.
2. Each group has 7 buttons.
3. Add 7 five times: $7 + 7 + 7 + 7 + 7 = 35$.
4. 5 groups of 7 make 35.

Answer: 35 buttons

1	Two toy bins each have 4 cars. Write repeated addition and find the total.	$4 + 4 = 8$ cars
2	Three puppy bowls each hold 2 treats. Write repeated addition and find the total.	$2 + 2 + 2 = 6$ treats
3	Four kids each put 3 stickers in an album. Write repeated addition and find the total.	$3 + 3 + 3 + 3 = 12$ stickers
4	A shelf has 6 stacks of 2 books. Describe the groups and find the total.	6 groups of 2 make 12 books
5	Three boxes each hold 4 crayons. Write repeated addition and find the total.	$4 + 4 + 4 = 12$ crayons

PART 2 • APPLY IT

1. **12 carrot pieces** There are 4 equal groups of 3. Add $3 + 3 + 3 + 3$ to get 12.
2. **18 trading cards** There are 3 equal groups of 6. Add $6 + 6 + 6$ to get 18.

CHALLENGE

No. There are 3 groups of 4, so add $4 + 4 + 4 = 12$ beads.

Accept repeated-addition or multiplication sentences that correctly show the equal groups and total. For the challenge, accept an explanation that $3 + 4$ does not show three equal groups, and that the total is 12.
