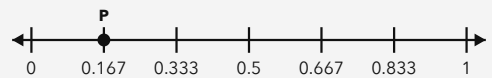

COUNT THE EQUAL SPACES

The spaces from 0 to 1 must be equal. Count all the equal spaces to find the denominator. Count the spaces from 0 to the point to find the numerator.

WORKED EXAMPLE

What fraction names point P? Write the fraction in sixths.

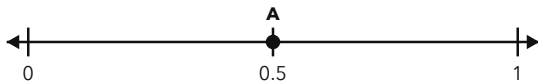


1. Count 6 equal spaces from 0 to 1.
2. Point P is 1 space to the right of 0.
3. Write 1 for the numerator and 6 for the denominator.

Answer: $\frac{1}{6}$

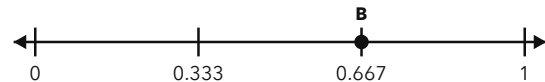

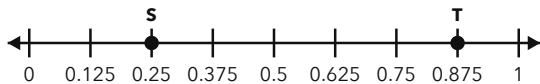
- 2** A music app download bar is divided into 6 equal parts. Four parts are filled. What fraction of the download is filled? Write it in sixths.

5	A number line from 0 to 1 is divided into 8 equal spaces. Point E is at the seventh tick after 0. What fraction names E? Write it in eighths.	7/8
6	A number line from 0 to 1 is divided into 4 equal spaces. Point F is at the first tick after 0. What fraction names F? Write it in fourths.	1/4

PART 2 • APPLY IT

1. **3/4** The track has 4 equal spaces. Point R is 3 spaces from 0, so the fraction is 3/4.
2. **4/6** There are 6 equal parts in all and 4 filled parts. Write 4/6.

CHALLENGE

S = 2/8; T = 7/8. T is closer to 1 because it is 1/8 away, while S is 6/8 away.

Students should use the denominator named in each prompt, so do not replace sixths or eighths with simplified equivalents. For the challenge explanation, accept any correct comparison showing that T is nearer to 1.
