DISTANCE FROM ZERO

A fraction on a number line tells how far a point is from 0. Count the equal spaces from 0, then write the number of spaces moved over the total number of equal spaces. Points farther right are farther from 0.

WORKED EXAMPLE

What fraction names point P?

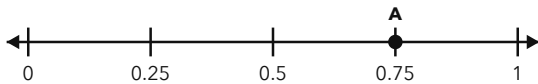


1. The line from 0 to 1 has 4 equal spaces.
2. Point P is 1 space to the right of 0.
3. Write spaces moved over total spaces:
 $\frac{1}{4}$.

Answer: $\frac{1}{4}$

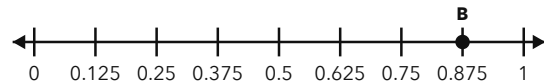

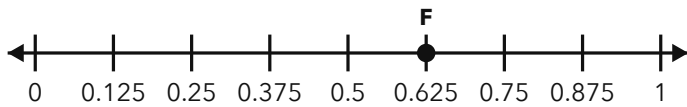

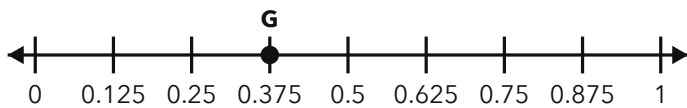

PART 2 • APPLY IT

- 5/8 mile** The number line is split into 8 equal spaces. Point F is 5 spaces from 0, so the distance is $\frac{5}{8}$ mile.
- 3/8** The meter has 8 equal spaces. Point G is 3 spaces to the right of 0, so Ava has finished $\frac{3}{8}$.

CHALLENGE

$\frac{1}{8}$, $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{7}{8}$. On a number line, the point farther right is farther from 0.

Accept equivalent fractions when they name the same location, except problem 5 should be written in fourths. For problem 6, accept "No, they both equal $\frac{1}{2}$ " or an equivalent explanation.
