COMPARE FINAL COSTS

A sale lowers the marked price right away. A coupon usually lowers the price at checkout, while a rebate lowers the final cost after you receive money back. To compare offers, find the final cost for each one and keep track of what you must pay at checkout.

WORKED EXAMPLE

A backpack costs \$90. It is on sale for 30% off, and you have a \$7 coupon. What is the final cost?

1. Find the sale discount: 30% of \$90 = $0.30 \times 90 = \$27$.
2. Subtract the sale discount: $\$90 - \$27 = \$63$.
3. Use the coupon: $\$63 - \$7 = \$56$.

Answer: \$56

A pair of earbuds is marked \$75. Store A gives 20% off and then lets you use a \$6 coupon. Store B lets you use a \$12 coupon and offers a \$9 mail-in rebate. You have only \$60 to spend today. Which store can you buy from today? After the rebate, which store has the lower final cost? Explain with prices.

PART 2 • APPLY IT

1. **Shop B has the lower final cost, \$35, which is \$1 less than Shop A's \$36.** At Shop A, 25% of \$48 is \$12, so the sale price is \$36. At Shop B, subtract the \$8 coupon and \$5 rebate from \$48 to get \$35.
2. **Store B has the lower final cost, \$27, which is \$1 less than Store A's \$28.** At Store A, $\frac{1}{3}$ of \$42 is \$14, so the final cost is \$28. At Store B, $\$42 - \$10 - \$5 = \27 .

CHALLENGE

You can buy from Store A today because its checkout price is \$54. Store B requires \$63 today, but its final cost after the \$9 rebate is \$54, so the final costs are equal.

Accept dollar signs as optional and equivalent money forms such as 40.50 for \$40.50. For rebate items, distinguish the checkout price from the final cost after the rebate.
