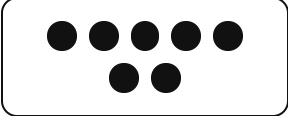

HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each row prompt aloud, then give students time to circle one number. In the second part, students count dots or read the printed number and write the matching whole number in each box.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY “Listen to each question. Look at the numbers in the row, then circle the number you hear.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Which number says zero? Circle it.	0
b	Which number says twelve? Circle it.	12
c	Which number says twenty? Circle it.	20

PART 2 • WRITE IT

SAY “Look at what is beside each box. What number does it show? Write that number in the box.”

- Box 1 (beside 7 dots): **7**
- Box 2 (beside 15): **15**
- Box 3 (beside 20): **20**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Circle-row answers are 0, 12, and 20. Accept recognizable number writing for 7, 15, and 20, including developmentally appropriate reversed digits if the intended number is clear.
