HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each prompt aloud, then give students a brief look before they circle one dot group. In Part 1, the dots are shown in organized patterns. In Part 2, the same small quantities are scattered, so students recognize how many without relying on an orderly pattern.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • NEAT DOTS

SAY “Look quickly at each row. Which dot group shows the number I say? Circle that group.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Which dot group shows three dots?	3 dots
b	Which dot group shows two dots?	2 dots

PART 2 • SCATTER DOTS

SAY “Now look quickly at each row of scattered dots. Which dot group shows the number I say? Circle that group.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Which dot group shows four dots?	4 dots
b	Which dot group shows one dot?	1 dots

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Accept a circle around the correct dot group in each row. Answers are Part 1: 3, 2. Part 2: 4, 1.
