HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read every prompt and group name aloud. Students collect shapes that fit one of three groups, then organize the same kinds of data by drawing lines to group names.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • FIND GROUPS

SAY “Listen to the group name in each question. Look at the three shapes, then circle the shape that belongs in that group.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Look at the circle, square, and triangle. Which shape belongs in the circle group? Circle it.	circle
b	Look at the square, triangle, and circle. Which shape belongs in the triangle group? Circle it.	triangle
c	Look at the triangle, square, and circle. Which shape belongs in the square group? Circle it.	square

PART 2 • SORT LINES

SAY “Look at the shapes on the left. I will read the group words on the right: triangle, circle, square. Draw a line from each shape to the word that names its group.”

- **circle** matches **circle**
- **square** matches **square**
- **triangle** matches **triangle**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Part 1 circles are circle, triangle, and square, in row order. Part 2 lines connect circle to circle, square to square, and triangle to triangle.
