**HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE**

Read all printed words aloud because students are not expected to read them independently. Students listen for ways people earn money, then circle a matching word and connect workers to their jobs.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

**PART 1 • CIRCLE IT**

**SAY** “Look at each row. I will read the words and a short story. Listen, then circle the word that answers my question.”

Circle row answers are sell, job, and work. Match baker to bakes, artist to draws, and farmer to grows; accept any clear connecting lines.
