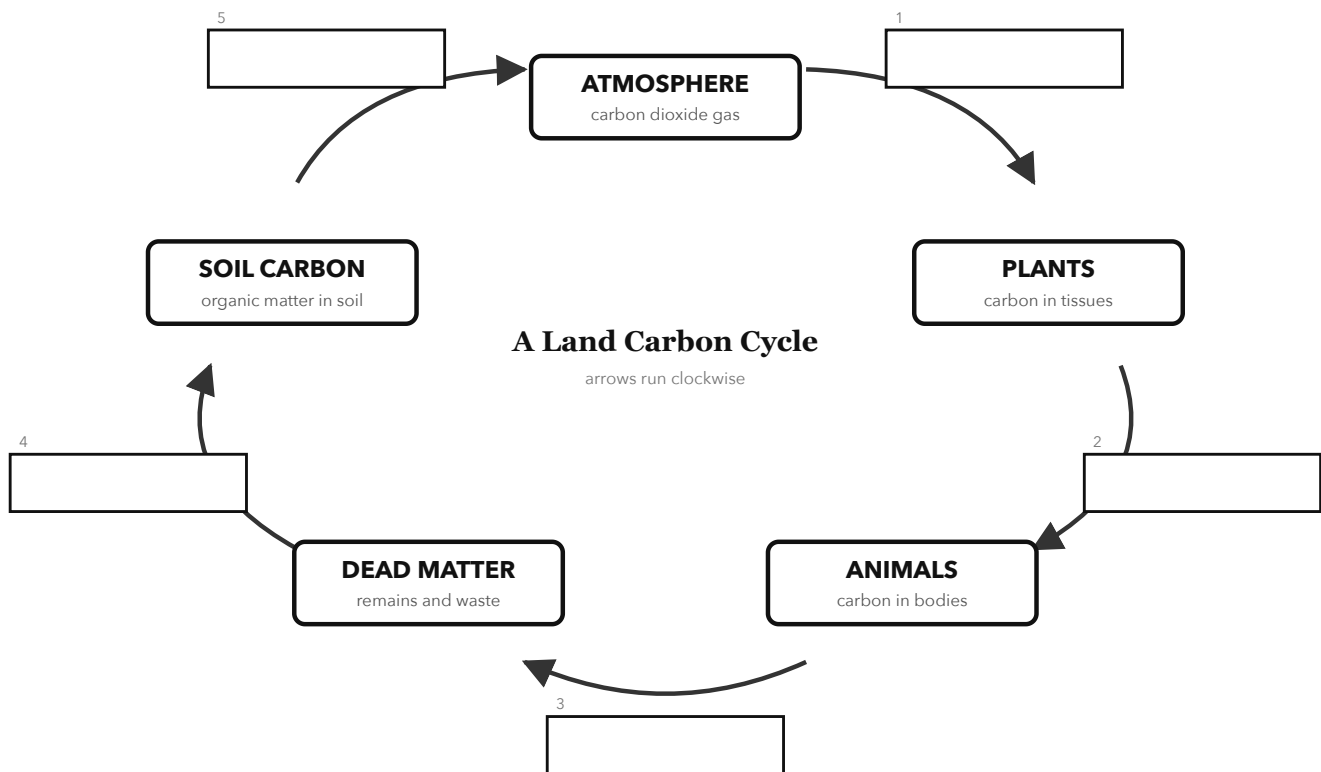

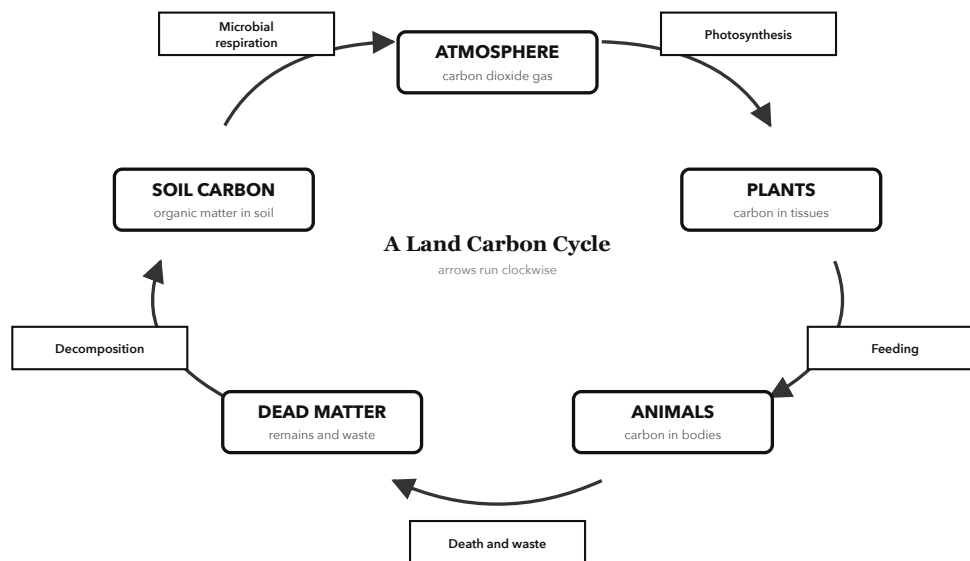

1. **Feeding** (Which process moves carbon from PLANTS to ANIMALS?)

3. **ATMOSPHERE** (Which stage receives carbon after microbial respiration?)

TEST THE MODEL (SAMPLE ANSWERS)

- This model leaves out carbon moving between the ocean and the atmosphere.
- This model leaves out fossil fuels being burned and releasing carbon dioxide.

The arrow answers, in order, are Photosynthesis, Feeding, Death and waste, Decomposition, and Microbial respiration. This simplified model shows one short-term land pathway, not every carbon reservoir or process.
