HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each weather word aloud before students mark the page. Students identify how weather can change from one day to the next, then connect each season with a weather pattern that often happens during that season.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • TODAY'S WEATHER

SAY "Listen to the weather story for each row. I will read the three weather words, then you will circle the word that tells about today."

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Yesterday was sunny. Today rain is falling. Which word tells about today's weather?	rainy
b	Yesterday was cold. Today the air feels warm. Which word tells about today's weather?	warm

PART 2 • SEASON MATCH

SAY "I will read the season words and the weather words. Draw a line from each season to weather that often happens in that season."

- **Spring** matches **rainy**
- **Summer** matches **hot**
- **Fall** matches **windy**
- **Winter** matches **cold**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Circle row answers are rainy, then warm. Match Spring to rainy, Summer to hot, Fall to windy, and Winter to cold; explain that weather can vary from place to place and from day to day.
