HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Choose a picture book with clear, separate pictures of the Sun, a full Moon, and a cloud. Show one page for each circle row, then let students look back at those pages as they match each sky word to a describing word.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY “I will show you a page from our sky book for each row. Look closely, listen to the words, and circle the word that names the sky object you see.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Look at this page. The words are Moon, Sun, and Cloud. Which word names the sky object you see?	Sun
b	Look at this page. The words are Moon, Star, and Sun. Which word names the sky object you see?	Moon
c	Look at this page. The words are Moon, Star, and Cloud. Which word names the sky object you see?	Cloud

PART 2 • MATCH WORDS

SAY “Look back at the sky pages. Draw a line from each sky word to the word that tells something about it.”

- **Sun** matches **bright**
- **Moon** matches **round**
- **Cloud** matches **puffy**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

For the circle rows, show a clear Sun page first, a full Moon page second, and a cloud page third. Matches are Sun to bright, Moon to round, and Cloud to puffy.
