HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Lead students in reciting both pledges aloud, then listen to each student or pair during Part 1. The tracing and matching help students connect each pledge name to print while you assess oral recitation.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • SAY AND TRACE

SAY "As you say each pledge, can you trace the name in its box? Say the United States Pledge with me: "I pledge allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America, and to the Republic for which it stands, one Nation under God, indivisible, with liberty and justice for all." Say the Texas Pledge with me: "Honor the Texas flag; I pledge allegiance to thee, Texas, one state under God, one and indivisible.""

- Box 1: **U.S.**
- Box 2: **Texas**

PART 2 • FIRST LETTERS

SAY "Look at the three words on the left and the three letters on the right. Can you draw a line from each word to its first letter?"

- **U.S.** matches **U**
- **Texas** matches **T**
- **Pledge** matches **P**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Accept recognizable tracing of U.S. and Texas. Matching is U.S. to U, Texas to T, and Pledge to P; assess that each student can recite both full pledges aloud, with teacher support if needed.
