HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each item aloud and have students circle the place connected to the anthem or motto. Then have students trace the two place names used on the page.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY "Listen to each special song name or motto. For each row, circle the word that tells where it belongs."
