**HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE**

Read each prompt aloud and give students time to make one mark. Students use a pencil and book for the first part, then use their bodies after you show them which way is north in the classroom.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

**PART 1 • OBJECT WORDS**

**SAY** “For each row, put your pencil and book where I say. Then listen to the words in the row and circle the word that tells where your pencil is compared with your book.”

**PART 2 • FIND NORTH**

**SAY** “Stand by your chair and face north, the way I point. For each row, turn your body as the row says, then circle the letter that names the direction you face.”

|-----|------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|-----------------|
| a   | Face north. Which letter names the direction you face? Circle N, E, S, or W.                   | <b>N</b>        |
| b   | Face north, then turn right. Which letter names the direction you face? Circle N, E, S, or W.  | <b>E</b>        |
| c   | Face north, then turn around. Which letter names the direction you face? Circle N, E, S, or W. | <b>S</b>        |
| d   | Face north, then turn left. Which letter names the direction you face? Circle N, E, S, or W.   | <b>W</b>        |
