Labels on Earth

- ① A map is a flat picture of Earth. A globe is a round model of Earth. Both can show land and water. A continent is a huge area of land. The seven continents are Africa, Antarctica, Asia, Australia, Europe, North America, and South America.
- ② The five oceans are Arctic Ocean, Atlantic Ocean, Indian Ocean, Pacific Ocean, and Southern Ocean. Oceans are large bodies of salt water. A river moves. A lake is surrounded by land. A mountain is high land. A plain is wide, flat land.
- ③ On a map or globe, blue often shows water, and other colors often show land. Labels tell what places are called. To find a place, look for its label, then decide whether it names land or water. Maps and globes help people locate features.
