Aunt's Bakery Job

- ① On Saturday, Maya's aunt works at a bakery. She mixes dough, puts bread in the oven, and helps customers. Her work gives her income, which is money she earns for doing a job. She saves some of this money.
- ② After work, Maya's aunt uses some income at the market. She buys apples and rice. Apples and rice are goods because people can take them home. She also pays a barber to cut her hair. A haircut is a service.
- ③ Maya notices that work helps people earn income. The bakery worker uses income to buy goods. The barber works to earn income too. People use income to pay for services such as haircuts or bus rides. Work and income help families get what they need.
