Three Texas Communities

- ① Texas is home to American Indian groups that have remained in the state. The Ysleta Del Sur Pueblo is in El Paso, at the far western edge of Texas. El Paso is near the Rio Grande and the border with New Mexico. When you locate this group, look to West Texas, not to the center or east of the state.
- ② The Alabama-Coushatta Tribe of Texas has its reservation near Livingston in Polk County. This area is in East Texas, among forests and pine trees. Livingston lies north of Houston and east of the middle of the state. A locator can use the county, the town, and the region together to place the Alabama-Coushatta in Texas.
- ③ The Kickapoo Traditional Tribe of Texas is near Eagle Pass in Maverick County. Eagle Pass is in South Texas, beside the Rio Grande and across from Mexico. This location is far from El Paso in the west and Livingston in the east. Comparing the three locations shows that these American Indian groups remain in different parts of Texas.
