HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read the four-sentence passage aloud twice, pointing to each sentence number as you read. Students listen for details, then mark the numbered sentence that gives proof for an idea. This models using evidence from a read-aloud and tracing where that evidence appears.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE PROOF

SAY “Listen as I read: Sentence 1: Mia put seeds in a pot. Sentence 2: She gave the pot water each morning. Sentence 3: Soon, a green sprout popped up. Sentence 4: Mia smiled and called Dad to see. I will ask about each row. Circle the sentence number that gives proof.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Which sentence tells that Mia gave the pot water? The choices are 1, 2, and 4. Which number will you circle?	2
b	Which sentence gives proof that a plant started to grow? The choices are 2, 3, and 1. Which number will you circle?	3
c	Which sentence gives proof that Mia wanted Dad to know about the sprout? The choices are 4, 2, and 3. Which number will you circle?	4

PART 2 • MATCH PROOF

SAY “Listen to the passage again. Read the words on the left with me: Planting, Caring, Sharing. Find the sentence number that gives proof for each word, then draw a line to it.”

- **Planting** matches **1**
- **Caring** matches **2**
- **Sharing** matches **4**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Circle-row answers are 2, 3, and 4. Match Planting to 1, Caring to 2, and Sharing to 4. Accept lines that clearly connect each word to its correct sentence number.
