HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each part aloud and point to the boxes in order. Watch for a functional pencil grasp, clear manuscript letter and number shapes, and careful sound-by-sound spelling.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • TRACE MARKS

SAY “Look at the three boxes. Can you trace the capital A and lowercase a in the first box, the capital T and lowercase t in the second box, and the number 8 in the third box?”

- Box 1: **Trace capital A and lowercase a legibly.**
- Box 2: **Trace capital T and lowercase t legibly.**
- Box 3: **Trace the number 8 legibly.**

PART 2 • WRITE WORDS

SAY “Listen for every sound. Say pan-cake slowly before you write it. Can you write cat in the first box, game in the second box, and pancake in the third box?”

- Box 1: **cat**
- Box 2: **game**
- Box 3: **pancake**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Accept recognizable manuscript forms with correct letter order. Accept cat, game, and pancake when each word is spelled correctly, with pancake written as one word.
