The Life of a Monarch

- ① Monarch butterflies are orange and black insects. In spring, many monarchs fly north from Mexico and California. They look for milkweed plants. A female monarch lays her eggs on milkweed leaves.
- ② After an egg hatches, a caterpillar eats milkweed. Then it forms a hard case called a chrysalis. Inside, the caterpillar changes. Later, an adult butterfly comes out and dries its wings.
- ③ Monarchs need safe places with flowers and milkweed. Flowers give adult butterflies nectar to drink. I think monarchs are amazing because they travel so far. A monarch's life has many stages.
