- ② Then Maya paused and continued, “After that, the caterpillar forms a chrysalis. Inside it, the caterpillar changes. Last, an adult butterfly comes out.” She used a calm voice and did not rush her words.
- ③ Maya looked at her classmates and asked, “What do you think the caterpillar does inside the chrysalis?” Ben answered, “It changes into a butterfly.” Maya said, “Yes. Thank you for listening.”
