A Beaver's Pond

- ① At dusk, a beaver carries a branch to a pond. It uses its wide, flat tail to steer while swimming. On the shore, it gnaws the branch with sharp front teeth and adds it to a dam.
- ② A dam is a wall of sticks, mud, and stones. It slows moving water, so a deeper pond forms behind it. The pond can make a safe place for the beaver's home, called a lodge.
- ③ Beavers work mostly at night, when fewer people are nearby. They carry mud with their front paws and press it into gaps. A strong dam helps keep the pond water deep, even when some water flows away.
