Crabs at the Shore

- ① At a rocky shore, a CRAB moves under a flat stone. Its hard shell keeps its body safe. When a gull flies above, the crab can SLIP into a small crack between rocks.
- ② Many crabs eat bits of plants and animals. They may leave TRACKS in wet sand when waves pull back. A crab uses its claws to pick up food, then it can rest near a CLAM.
- ③ Near the water, small fish swim through green seagrass. Sunlight can FLASH on a tide pool, where tiny sea animals may stay for a short time. The pool changes when the sun warms it or another wave splashes in.
